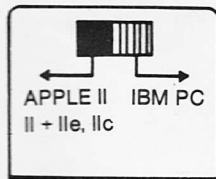

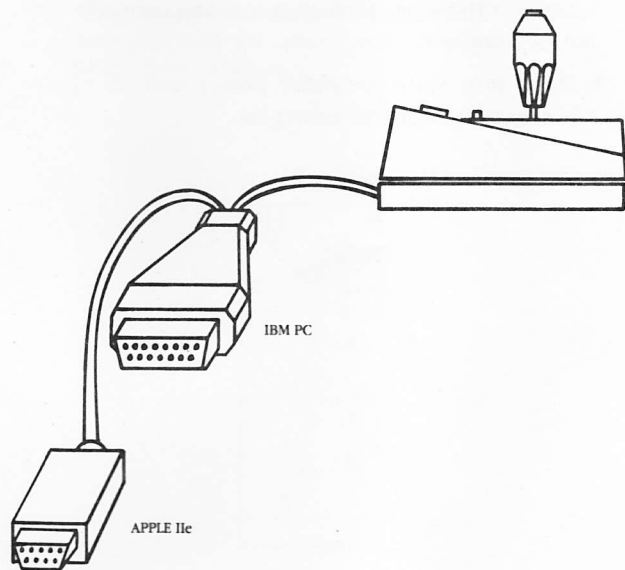
Selection Switch

There's a select switch on the bottom of the joystick. Switch it to the correct position for your computer.



Select the right connector

- If you have an Apple or compatible computer, select the 9 pin plug.
- If you have an IBM or compatible computer, select the 15 pin plug.



Installation Instructions

After you have selected the right connector for your computer,

1. turn your computer power and all other connected peripherals power off,
2. connect the joystick connector to the connector of your computer,
3. then, turn your computer power and all other connected peripherals power on.

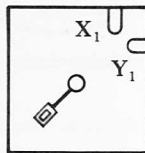
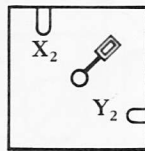
"Auto-Centering & "Free-Floating" modes

1. "Auto-Centering" mode

The 4 switches are in 'ON' positions.

2. "Free-Floating" mode

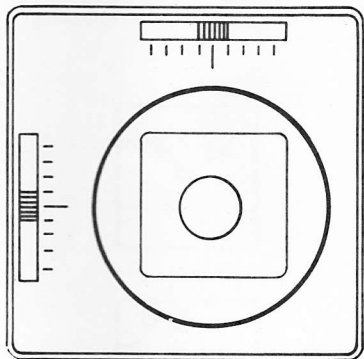
Hold the control stick to the corner as indicated in the diagram and turn the 2 switches X_2 & Y_2 from 'ON' to 'OFF' position. Move the control stick to the opposite corner and turn the other 2 switches X_1 & Y_1 from 'ON' to 'OFF' position.



Fine Adjustments

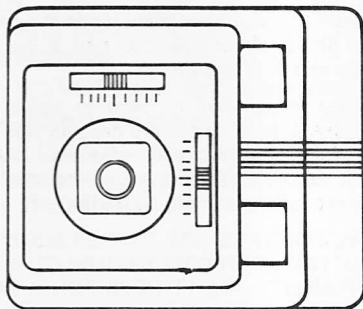
The two levers on the top of the joystick are fine adjustments. You can use these adjustments to position the object you will be controlling with your joystick. Each lever controls a separate axis (X or Y).

The X lever controls the left and right positions and the Y lever controls the up and down positions.



Fire Button Operation

1. There are two buttons on the base of the joystick to accommodate either right or left handed users.
2. The optional fire button in the stick tip acts independently of the other buttons.
